Work Session on Character Study: The Council held its fourth and final open work session as part of the character study of Chevy Chase View. Chris Jakubiak reviewed the selection of "sample" lots in the Town that were studied, and gave a detailed analysis as to how this selection of 13 homes in the Town allowed the consultants to establish elements of existing characteristics of the Town. The Council discussed the sample lots, groupings of character areas, and building, site, and lot size elements they exhibited.
