
Senator Waldstreicher, Delegates Carr, Shetty, Solomon

- ▶ Saul Road & Connecticut Avenue (MD 185) Safety Improvements (D-18) Community Discussion on November 5th, 2019.
- ▶ MDOT SHA reviewed safety conditions at the Saul Road and MD 185 location. A traffic signal reconstruction project was approved by MDOT SHA's Office of Traffic and Safety (OOTTS) and will include protected left turns along MD 185.
- ▶ The project is in the Design Phase. Construction is anticipated for Spring 2021.

- ▶ In May 2020, MDOT SHA initiated a comprehensive corridor needs study for MD 185 between Western Ave/Chevy Chase Cir and MD 193. Estimated completion Winter 2020-2021.
- ▶ Study goal is to establish a long-term vision for the corridor and identify strategies to address pedestrian and bicycle network deficiencies.
- ▶ Corridor will be evaluated segment by segment to provide context-sensitive concepts for transportation improvements that address all roadway users.

- ▶ The goal of MDOT SHA is to develop all improvements along state roadways through a context-sensitive lens
- ▶ The Context Driven approach aims to balance access and mobility

- ▶ MD 586 at Norris Drive – New Traffic Signal/Continental Crosswalk
- ▶ MD 586 at Andrews Street – HAWK Signal with Continental Crosswalk

KENSINGTON/GARRETT PARK

- ▶ MD 192 at Kensington MARC Station – New RRFBs/Continental Crosswalk
- ▶ MD 547 at Kensington Library – New RRFBs/Continental Crosswalk

CHEVY CHASE/GLENMONT

- ▶ MD 182 at Greenery Lane – New HAWK Signal with Continental Crosswalk
- ▶ MD 410/East West Highway at Edgevale Street – New RRFBs
- ▶ MD 410/East West Highway at Montgomery Lane – New Pedestrian Signal
