**Work Session on Town's Current Driveway and Driveway Apron**

**Permit Process:** The Council held work session to discuss trends in building and resultant impervious front-yard coverage, including driveways. Mr. Toomey presented options for Council consideration. Following discussions, the Council directed the Town Attorney to prepare an ordinance for further review, limiting front-yard non-vegetative surface coverage to 30%.
