Jason Azar of Clark/Azar presented his summary of the bids received for the Summit Avenue sidewalk replacement, noting that the type of variations seen in these bids is not uncommon in today's market for projects such as this. Clark/Azar attempted to contact all the references for each contractor and for two of them there was no response.

All the ECM Corporation references responded positively, and had included in their price using Creative Concrete for the specified coloring and stamping. For these and other reasons, Jason Azar recommended that CCV engage ECM Corporation as the Town contractor for this project. Paula Fudge made a motion to award the bid to ECM Corporation. Carlos Molina seconded the motion and it passed 5-0.
