The Council met to discuss Montgomery County's proposed Memorandum of Understanding to share revenues from speed cameras on Connecticut Avenue with the Towns of Chevy Chase View and Kensington. Mike Plantamura, Lulu Gonella and Jana Coe reported that on August 31, 2009, they attended a meeting with Town of Kensington and Montgomery County officials, at which MCPD traffic safety officials explained the factors used to determine the proposed locations of the cameras.

The Council authorized David Podolsky to draft a Memorandum of Understanding reflecting a counter-proposal to Montgomery County.
